This person should also have knowledge and understanding of working within a combination ((part-time/volunteer) department. The Chief is responsible for all aspects of a modern day fire department operations including; fire suppression, fire prevention, fire investigation, budgeting, strategic planning, Emergency Medical Services, emergency management and public education. The Chief reports to the Village Administrator and is expected to provide leadership and integrity to all employees.

Preferred Qualifications include:

- 1) 10 years in the Fire Service with at least 4 years of command level experience as a Company Officer (Lieutenant, Captain, Assistant/Deputy Chief or Chief);
- 2) An Associates Degree in Fire Science or Management or a combination of education, experience and training that clearly defines the applicant's ability to perform the described essential functions of the position;
- 3) Certification in the State of Ohio as FF-1B and certification as an EMT-B;
- 4) Certification as an Ohio Fire Safety Inspector;
- 5) Experience as an Instructor in either Fire and/or EMS ;
- 6) Experience in Hazardous/Material Operations with Operations or Technician certification;
- 7) Thorough knowledge of the NIMS National Curriculum's, Incident Command System with Certification of ICS-100, ICS-300, ICS-400and ICS-700.
